



#### Working Standard Anti-pneumococcal serotype 6A/C monoclonal antibody NIBSC code: 21/274 Instructions for use (Version 1.0, Dated 22/11/2022)

# 1. INTENDED USE

Monoclonal antibody 21/274 (Clone 14-107JG10 IA1/IB1 IIG10) is intended for use as a serotyping reagent. It is suitable for use in a variety of immunoassays for the detection and quantification of pneumococcal capsular polysaccharide 6A and 6C (Pn6A/C).

## 2. CAUTION

# 4. CONTENTS

Country of origin of biological material: United States.

Each vial contains 0.5 mL of liquid anti-pneumococcal serotype 6A/C monoclonal antibody at a total protein concentration of 1 mg/mL. 21/274 is a murine IgG1 kappa antibody produced from hybridoma and purified by mabSelect. The hybridoma was produced using a purified Pn6A specific polysaccharide conjugate for the immunisation of mice. The antibody is in Phosphate Buffer pH 7.2.

#### 5. STORAGE

The material should be stored between -20°C and -80°C Material type: Liquid – will be shipped according to the storage and shipping conditions of the product

#### 6. DIRECTIONS FOR OPENING

Vials have a screw cap; an internal stopper may also be present. The cap should be removed by turning anti-clockwise. Care should be taken to prevent loss of the contents. Please note: If a stopper is present on removal of the cap, the stopper should remain in the vial or be removed with the cap.

## 7. USE OF MATERIAL

21/274 has been used in a sandwich ELISA for detection of Pn6A and Pn6C. The most suitable dilution for use of this antibody should be determined by the end user for their specific application.




